The first two days were spent in Red Mesa, Arizona. Brother Dan Dee brought some of the best in Native Gospel Music together for a glorious tent meeting. Apostle Negiel played keyboard and sang, worshipping the Lord in an awesome anointing each evening. Apostle Jay brought the Word of the Lord to the people on the second evening, and all were blessed mightily.

The team was fed delicious Navajo food and they made some wonderful new friends. Rabbi Curt Landry arranged for food and clothing to be
