Dr. Bigpond also spoke at the Summer Madness Conference for thousands of youth, where he also had the honor of meeting Prince Andrew from England. It was a powerful time of commissioning and release based on Jeremiah 1:4-10 and 2 Timothy 2:2-4.

## Navaho Reservation Report

The largest reservation in the United States as well as one of the largest tribes, both Dr. Bigpond and his wife Jan were able to go on this trip to the four corners area. The purpose of the trip was to minister to hundreds of youth at a "Youth Jam". It was wonderful to see our Native youth respond with such a hunger for instruction and guidance as he commissioned and released them. The Lord gave Dr. Bigpond a vision to the Navaho nation which he was able to release to the pastors and leaders.

Dr. Bigpond also spoke at Pastor Jack Webb's church in Albuquerque, where he commissioned and released the intercessors into warfare.

Dr. Bigpond was commissioned by Dr. Swallow to attend a military funeral for a 19 year old Navaho soldier killed in Afghanistan. The young man was a warrior who brought honor to his country. Please lift his family up in prayer for God's peace and comfort.
