Healing Ancient Wounds Continues

In November 2005 a group of prayer warriors of Native American and European heritage met at Thorn Crown Worship Center in Eureka Springs, AR, to corporately repent and reconcile for centuries-old wounds and atrocities suffered on both sides. A highlight of the evening was when Sen. Jim Holt, (AR), repented after reading the Apology to the Native Americans (SR-15). Please continue to call forth sponsors for this resolution and for it to arrive on the Senate floor for vote in our Father's timing.

The team also went to Blue Springs, an area where the Cherokee were forced to camp during the winter of 1838. During the encampment, the people in the surrounding region blessed them with food and supplies and this was established a place of blessing. Chris Seaton from England felt the need to repent for broken covenants between Great Britain and the Native Peoples made prior to Statehood.

The following day we traveled to Tahlequah, final destination for the forced removal. This was intensely emotional. It's one thing to read the history of land sites but when you step back into that time and place, you hear the land and people crying out, we must allow the Holy Spirit to bring forth an inner strength to forgive and bless.
